1. SUBJECT AND OBJECTIVE

Palexpo SA operates Wi-Fi 802.11abg technology continuously across the whole of the PALEXPO site in order to offer its clients this service.

Palexpo SA is publishing these terms and conditions so as to allow coexistence of Palexpo's Wi-Fi installations with those of exhibitors:

- 1.a Palexpo SA operates Wi-Fi 802.11abg technology continuously in the exhibition halls
- 1.b **Palexpo SA authorises exhibitors, organisers and all authorised companies to make partial use of the Wi-Fi 802.11abg technology in the exhibition halls in compliance with these terms and conditions**
- 1.c With respect to communal areas, in others words, the entrance halls, restaurants, offices, meeting rooms and multifunctional rooms, Palexpo SA does not authorise any Wi-Fi installation other than its own infrastructure. In the event of a desire to operate a private Wi-Fi network in these areas, a complete dossier (as per Point 4) containing due grounds for the need for such a network must be submitted to us in advance in order to obtain exceptional authorisation.

All Wi-Fi installations are therefore governed and limited in accordance with the following rules:

2. STANDARDS AND CHANNELS AVAILABLE

The standards and channels available are:

- Standard 802.11a – to be programmed as automatic; maximum of 2 access points per stand
- Standard 802.11bg – channels 11 to 13 only; maximum of 2 access points per stand

3. SIGNAL STRENGTH AND SSID

It is important that exhibitors restrict signal strength to cover their own stand only.

It is possible to broadcast SSIDs using «broadcast» mode.

4. OBLIGATION TO REPORT INSTALLATIONS

All Wi-Fi installations must be reported to the Telecom (ICT) service at Palexpo SA by e-mail to telematics@geneva-Palexpo.ch, the following information to be provided:

- a. Name and number of stand;
- b. Name and contact details of person present on the stand at the start of the event;
- c. E-mail address and mobile phone number of responsible technician;
- d. Make and model of the equipment installed on the PALEXPO site;
- e. SSID(s) to be parameterised;

- f. Signal strength used;
- g. Radio channel signal used in compliance with this document;
- h. Precise installation plan showing the access point(s) on the stand;
- i. Planned dates of use (assembly, dismantling, event itself);

The information requested must be sent no later than one week before the event opens.

5. SANCTIONS IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE

- Wi-Fi 802.11 a/b/g equipment that does not comply with these terms and conditions and therefore interferes with the networks must be disabled immediately upon request from Palexpo SA staff. Reactivation will be permitted only after appropriate modification of the configuration.
- Palexpo SA is also entitled to demand the dismantling of any Wi-Fi installation not reported in advance.
- Palexpo SA will invoice its costs without notice at an hourly rate of CHF 240.00 to exhibitors having one or more access points that have not been reported or that do not comply with the current terms and conditions. By the deployment of one or more access points, the organiser, exhibitor or any authorised company automatically accepts these terms and conditions as well as our «General Terms and Conditions of Internet Access», which are available on our website at www.palexpo.ch/Services/Reglementation/index.php

In any event, costs relating to the location of equipment and costs arising from non-compliance with these terms and conditions will be charged to the stand involved.

The French version of these Terms and Conditions is legally binding.
